Memorandum of Understanding may be set forth in a separate agreement.

- CKEC may provide human resources and infrastructural facilities at their premises for all development activities carried out through C.R.I. pumps.
- CKEC may provide the sufficient number of participants for each training/skill development program as per agreement.
- C.R.I. Pumps may facilitate employment opportunities and internship programs for the students of CKEC.
- 8. The terms of specific areas of cooperation, which are deployed in CKEC or C.R.I. Pumps, shall be further considered and agreed upon in writing by the parties prior to the initiation of any particular activity.
- Any specific program will be subject to mutual consent, availability of resources and approval of both parties.

Working Arrangements

- 10. In order to progress opportunities for mutual co-operation, it is agreed that there will be meetings at a senior level between the two parties. Other meetings will be arranged at an appropriate level to progress trainings/internships. The date and location of meetings have to be mutually agreed between the parties.
- 11. This Memorandum of Understanding will be effective from the date of its signature by both parties and will be valid for a period of five years. Both parties agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after five years and acknowledge that this Memorandum is subject to revision/termination at any time by three months notice by either party. However, termination of this Memorandum shall not affect the arrangements under specific contracts signed between the parties that shall continue in accordance with the terms and conditions under those specific contracts.
- 12. The parties agree that each may publish or advertise the existence of the collaboration between the parties pursuant to this Memorandum and such collaborative activities are undertaken in promotion of this Memorandum provided that prior approval of the other party is first obtained on all such marketing and related materials before publication.

CLAUSES

- 1.2. Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 1.3. Internships, Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The internship, industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 1.4. Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

1.5. Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.

- 1.6. Second party may outsource / discuss the industrial research and implementation problem in engineering domain to First party as research consultation.
- 1.7. Both Parties are abide to all internal / affiliating bodies' rules, protocols, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.
- 1.8. All financial transactions between both parties must be transparent and documented. All transactions must be through knowledge of the agreed representatives of the parties.

2. CO-OPERATION

- 2.1. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings through "Training & Placement Cell (TPC)". The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 2.2. Whenever Second party provides stipend to the students (working as intern with Second party) of First party. The 20% of the mentioned stipend is agreed to sanction to the Research / Laboratory development consultation activity of First party by the Second party, during the course duration (with First party) of the those students.
- 2.3. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

2.1. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

2.2. Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

2.2. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period both parties will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. 2.3. Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

2.1. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 2.2. It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
- 2.3. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of New Delhi.
