The Institution and the Training Partner, wherever the context so admits and requires, shall hereinafter be individually referred to as "Party" and collectively referred to as "Parties"

- C. WHEREAS the Training Partner will be conducting robotics education services to the students across all semesters.
- D. WHEREAS this agreement enables the Institution for the arrangement of the training provider's activities such as giving training in Robotics and Coding to the students.
- E. WHEREAS both the parties have represented to each other that they are legally competent to enter into this agreement and are duly authorized by their respective constituent documents / bye-laws in the regard.

Accordingly, both the Parties hereto out of their free will, in exchange of various valuable considerations and covenants contained hereinafter, desirous of reducing to writing the terms & conditions of such an association, their part of duties, responsibilities and work etc. as also their rights hereunder, record and agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions: -

Responsibility of The Training Partner

- The Training Partner agrees to provide paid workshops/ semester-long co-curricular programs/ any special programs jointly envisioned to the students, relating to Robotics and Coding education and issue Program Certificates to the students.
- The Training Partner agrees to provide training lesson plan to The Institution. The Institution
 agrees to provide a schedule for the sessions before commencement of the program, that is
 mutually acceptable.
- The Training Partner agrees to record the attendance relating to incoming and outgoing of the trainers of the Training Partner by way of attendance register available at the Associated Institutions.
- 4. DIYA's mentor will be present during the days and time of the sessions planned.
- 5. Computer Lab provided by the Institution should have Projector, speakers, mike, white board and accessories. Internet has to be provided to all the systems. Robotic kits are purchased and maintained by the Institution.

6. In event of any complimentary offerings, DIYA shall keep the institution notified of the same, so that the students can benefit from the same.

Responsibility of The Institution

- 1. The Institution shall make use of DIYA's expertise where ever required in terms of conducting short-term and long-term courses.
- 2. The Institution shall ensure provision of the infrastructure as per the requirements of DIYA with regards to computers, projector, internet and other items. DIYA shall share the list of requirements with the Institution prior to each engagement.
- 3. The Institution agrees to complete the paperwork for DIYA in terms of the programs being delivered and support in terms of testimonials and photos of the program.
- 4. The Institution shall at their own discretion choose to work with DIYA on any of the complimentary offerings, which DIYA may announce from time to time.
- 5. The Institution may approach DIYA for support with any industrial projects they are taking up and DIYA at its discretion will choose to engage with the Institution on the same. The monetary consideration for the same will be agreed mutually on mail.
- 6. The Institution will share suitable candidate profiles with DIYA based on the internship and fulltime roles available with DIYA.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

Both the Parties will protect the Confidential Information which may be received by a Party in pursuance of this MOU and keep confidentiality of the same with the same degree of care as each Party would take in respect of its own confidential information. The Parties will use such confidential information only to serve the purpose for which it was intended and furnished to the other Party. The obligation of confidentiality under this MOU will continue for five (5) years from the date of expiration or prior termination of this MOU.

Provided that the obligation of confidentiality will not be applicable where —

- i. Disclosure of such information is required by law, rules or regulations, or
- ii. It is known by the concerned Party without restriction prior to disclosure under this MOU; or
- iii. It is disclosed to the concerned Party by a third party without an obligation of confidentiality; or
- iv. It is available to the public through no fault of the concerned Party; or

The language of the arbitration proceedings shall be English. The Arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any re-enactment or statutory modifications thereof. The decision of the Sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the Parties.

The venue of the Arbitration shall be Chennai.

AMENDMENTS

This MOU shall constitute the entire understanding between the parties and supersede all prior or contemporaneous communications. All amendments to the MOU shall be in writing, duly signed by the parties to this MOU.

TERMINATION OF MoU

i) This MoU may be terminated by either of the Parties with sixty (60) days of the notice in this behalf

having been served on it by the other Party.

ii) In addition to the reasons for termination as set forth above, this MoU may be terminated forthwith if either of the Parties voluntarily or involuntarily enters into bankruptcy or similar re-organization

proceedings or if applications invoking such proceedings have been filed.

NOTICES

i) All notices and other communications required to be served on COLLEGE NAME and DIYA EduLabs Pvt Ltd under the terms of this MoU, shall be considered duly served if the same is delivered by way of registered post, courier service, personal delivery, fax or through electronic mail

to the Party at its last known address of business.

If the force majeure conditions continue beyond six (6) months, the Parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action.
