Responsibilities of Teaching Faculty

- The Staff members are expected to work with high standards, initiative, efficiency and economy. He / She will apply himself / herself diligently and faithfully to the work, that may be assigned to him/her from time to time and will conform to such directions that shall be given to him/her by their superiors.
- The Staff members will devote their entire time to the work assigned to them and will not undertake any work or business, honorarium or with remuneration. Any contravention shall attract termination.
- In addition to teaching, they will be required to take active interest and participate in the development process at the college including seminars, workshops, research and publications, nurturing of Institute Industry Interface and other academic and corresponding activities. They should also take up additional responsibilities assigned to them by the Principal, Correspondent and Chairman from time to time.



Institute Admission Policy

- The College ensures transparency in the admission process by strictly adhering to the guidelines issued by the AICTE, Government of Tamil Nadu, Directorate of Technical Education and Anna University.
- Eligibility criteria will be strictly followed.
- Admission through Management Quota is done through various schemes such as Christian Minority admission, merit scholarship, sports, first generation graduate etc.
- Staying at hostels is optional for the candidates who got admission
- For day scholars, travel through college bus is optional
- Tuition fee is decided by the State Government / Affiliating University
- Only after complete verification educational and other relevant certificates in original and further after the DoTE approval, candidates can continue their studies.
- Number of seats in engineering courses may vary every year based on the current scenario and demand.
